Navigating FCA CMS


General Information:

Superscripting / Subscripting: Pay careful attention to the copydeck for trademark symbols / disclaimers, and make sure to superscript or subscript when it is required. Always verify in QA to make sure that the information you add to the CMS appears in QA, and that there are no issues (whether content entry, or bugs that may require attention from DEVS)

Hanging letters/numbers: When possible, always make sure that features or numbers do not hang at the end of a sentence (see screenshot below). Be sure to line break in these cases.



Appsuite Refresh: When you modify anything in the ASSETS section in CMS, you should always run the Appsuite Content Script found at the bottom of the ASSETS section (see screenshot). Do not "Create new MY refresh for new year", this should not be run.



Each content module corresponds to a section on the website:


Whybuys: refer to the four pillars on the bottom, each describing a car model

Nonexpandable Module: Refers to a story on the website, these can be found in multiple sections (Design, Efficiency, Safety, Technology) and have a corresponding image (though not all have one) that can be found on the FCA server.

Feature Article: Homepage has a feature article which can be seen in the corresponding website image.


Key Features Boxes: These refer to the overview pillars seen in the website. Each key feature box describes one of the four features (Design, Efficiency, Technology and Safety)

NamePlate Module: Refers to the heading for the overview section (as with other sections, Design, Efficiency... etc)

Trim Tray: This refers to the various "trims" of a particular car model. There is a base trim, and higher trims which are variants of the base with special features. The description of these can be modified in the "Trims" section in the CMS

For Chrysler brand cars excluding Fiat, the models follow a specific way of entering information in the CMS. The design section is divided into two sections, exterior and interior. The exterior section includes the colourizer and wheelizer, which falls under the nameplate module on the website. Underneath this is the design stories, which include images to the left or right (you can alter the position in the CMS).

Nonexpandable Module: These contain the stories for the design section

Colours & Wheels: By adding this module, you can add colours/wheels in the ASSETS section of CMS (Colourizer & Wheelizer).


Interior Fabrics: Adding this module is similar to Colourizer & Wheels. You can add the fabrics in the

ASSETS section in CMS.


Video Content Module: This module allows you to add video content to a story, similar to nonexpendable modules.

Mobile Module: Mobile modules allow you to add content for the mobile platform. They are the same as regular nonexpendable modules in regards to content, though rules for line breaks differ.

Nameplate Module: Refers to the heading of the design section.




GALLERIES

CMS

The gallery can be accessed from the ASSETS button in CMS. To add an image to the gallery, scroll down to the bottom of the page. You will be asked to choose either an exterior or interior image of the model. Add both a thumbnail and main image for the image and a description (if available) + Alt text.







COLOURIZER

CMS

Access the colourizer from the ASSETS button. This is where you add different body colours for the car model. You will add both an English and French translation to the colour description at the bottom. Additionally, you will need to select the hex code of the colour. For this I suggest downloading an addon for your browser (Firefox / Chrome) called ColorZilla. You will need to find an image of the car model, and manual select a pixel that best represents the cars true color, copy the hex code from ColorZilla and past it into the Hex field in CMS.






WHEELIZER

CMS

The wheelizer can be access through the ASSETS button in CMS. Like the colourizer, you can select the wheel type from the top, and modify / add the descriptions / wheel standard on the bottom. You can add all images and then save, rather than adding and saving each wheel type individually.







INTERIORIZER

CMS

The interiorizer can be access through the ASSETS button in the CSM. The interiorizer corresponds to the interior section found within the design section of the website. You can add an image and respective text. There are two sections where text can be found, do not forget to add text to both fields.





FABRICIZER

CMS

Similar to the colourizer/interiorizer, the fabricizer can be found within the ASSETS section of CMS. Attach the image and description to each type of fabric and save. The fabricizer can be found on the interior section of the design page, underneath the three interior panels.






HOME GALLERIES

Like the galleries section, the home galleries section is featured on the brand homepage (see screenshot). It functions like the galleries section, except there is no exterior/interior selector.






DISCLAIMERS

Make sure that when you paste text into the disclaimer section that the font is comparable to other entries. If it is too big, try copying into notepad or sublime text first, and then copying/pasting from either of those programs.
